

14th Dec LEEDS SFA U11 v HULL SFA U11 – Yorkshire Federation League

A scrappy game was decided in favour of Leeds midway through the second half after a strong defensive display by Hull. On a heavy pitch Leeds struggled to get the passing game going to break down Hull's solid defensive line. Chances were at a premium in the first half and Leeds squandered opportunities which came its way. The second half brought a much improved display from Leeds and Joshua Jordaan led the way with strong running and a dominant physical presence and with livewire midfield dynamo Alfie McBride pulling the strings Leeds began to gain control. Jordaan burst through the Hull defence to bring a smart save from the Hull keeper and shortly afterwards Zack Carroll hit the post with a snap shot. Hull was dangerous on the break and Harry Keeligan –Wright needed to be alert on numerous occasions to thwart the lively Hull striker. Mc Bride hit two shots narrowly wide before a long range shot from Carroll was parried by the keeper to Freddie Walton who gleefully found the back of the net to give Leeds the lead. Hull responded well to the setback and Leeds keeper George Fletcher made a brave point blank save before Jordaan cleared the rebound off the line. Hull never gave up trying but Leeds continued to threaten without being on top of their game. A vital three points to move Leeds up the table before the Christmas break.
